HCSO Investigators Seek to Identify Robbery Suspect

Hanover, VA – On Friday, March 11, 2016, at approximately 1:18 p.m., the Sheriff's Office responded to Citizens and Farmers Bank located at 7021 Mechanicsville Turnpike for a report of a robbery. The black male suspect approached a teller, displayed a note indicating he was armed, and demanded money. The suspect left the bank with an undisclosed amount of currency.

The suspect is a black male, wearing a tan colored hat, black t-shirt with white sleeves underneath, dark colored cargo shorts, and black and white tennis shoes. The suspect was seen leaving the area in a silver Mercedes traveling eastbound on Mechanicsville Turnpike.
