Immediate Arrest Made in Stolen Vehicle Case

Hanover, Va. – On Monday, December 13, 2021, at 2:18 a.m., deputies responded to the 8200 block of Ferrill Court for a reported stolen vehicle. Once on scene, deputies immediately relayed the description of the stolen vehicle to patrol units in the area. Shortly after, a deputy located a vehicle matching that description on Lee Davis Road. A traffic stop was initiated and it was determined that this was in fact the reported stolen vehicle.

The vehicle was occupied by five individuals, all of whom were from Virginia Beach. Based upon the investigation that followed, all five individuals were identified, arrested and transported to Pamunkey Regional Jail.

Four adults and one juvenile were charged with the following:

- Chance Josiah Evans, 22. Charge: Grand Larceny (F)
- Davione Charles Badgett, 23. Charge: Grand Larceny (F)
- Jawan Taki Johnson, 19. Charge: Grand Larceny (F)
- Tony Lamont Allen, Jr, 18. Charges: Grand Larceny (F), Entering/Setting Vehicle in Motion (M)

The juvenile was also charged with Grand Larceny (F).
